This week's Legend is **Peyton Green** in **3-6 C**. **Peyton** is a happy, responsible and respectful Northie who always follows the 5 School Expectations.



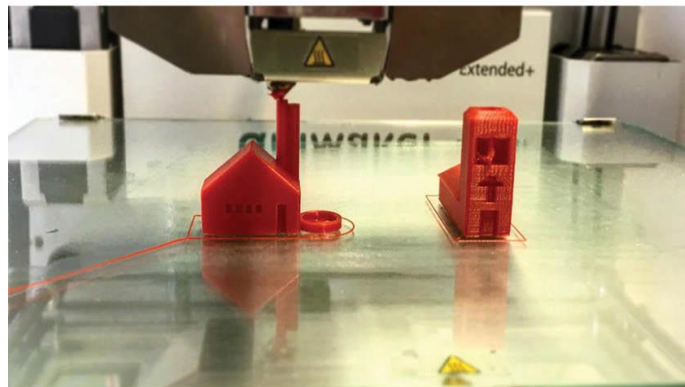
Book Week Assembly
